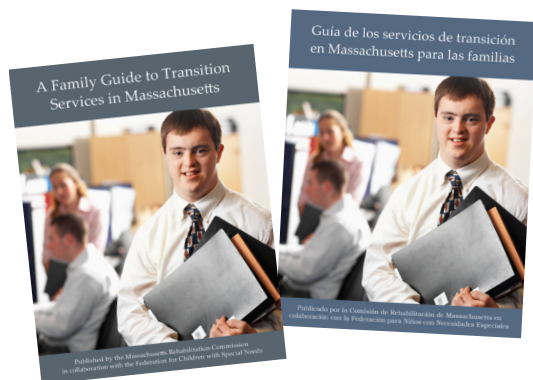


### **LINK Center: Connecting to Your Future Transition Information (ages 14-26)**

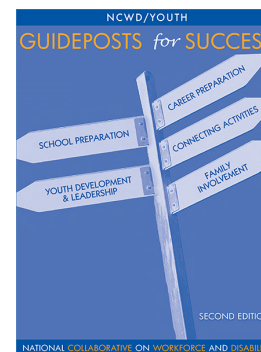
