Elections are on May 23rd.

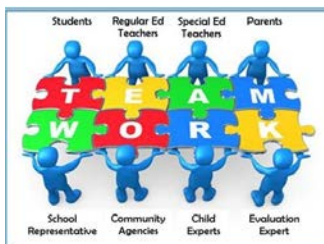
