- Woodcock Johnson, achievement section (or another comparable test, e.g., Kaufman Test of Educational Achievement)
- Most recent IEP
- Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale (WAIS) and a full protocol (all sub-test scores and verbal, performance, and full scale scores) and a written report
- Adaptive behavior rating scale (e.g., Vineland or BASC)

- High school transcript (or a certificate of completion)
- Certificate of completion or diploma
