



The Autism Program at Boston Medical Center is seeking MENTORS and MENTEES for an innovative program Teens Engaged as Mentors (TEAM)

Mentors

- High school/post-secondary students with and without autism spectrum disorder (Ages 14-21)

Mentees

- Elementary/middle school students with autism spectrum disorder (Ages 9-13)

Participants should not require 1:1 staffing or engage in aggressive or self-injurious behavior.

All mentors will receive training and supervision at the start of the program.

Events are once per month on weekends during daytime hours.

Participation at all events is required.

All events are staffed by trained facilitators through Boston Medical Center.

Parents do not participate but are responsible for their child's transportation.

This program is free of cost to participants.
