Accessible Taxi Cabs in Boston – WAVs

- Accessible taxi cabs in Boston are known as **WAVs** – this stands for **W**heelchair **A**ccessible **V**ehicles.
- WAVs are part of the City’s general taxi fleet and operate just like standard cabs – you can hail them on-street or call ahead for pick-up.
- You don’t have to fill out any applications or schedule your trips in advance to use WAVs.
- There are **100** WAVs in Boston, licensed by the Boston Police Hackney Unit. Each WAV has a Taxi Medallion License plate with a number on the back of its vehicle.

Accessibility Ratings on Boston WAVs

- Not all WAVs in Boston are ADA compliant. In 2017, there are **45** fully ADA Compliant WAVs, while the other 55 have varying levels of access.
- All 100 WAVs are rated for ADA compliance & accessibility using a scale of “**A - F**”. WAVs rated “**A**” are ADA compliant, WAVs rated “**F**” have very limited accessibility.
- Accessibility Ratings are posted on the back of each WAV next to the Taxi Medallion License. Look next to the small wheelchair sticker for a **BLUE LETTER** grade of: **A, B, C, D, F**. For a full list of ratings, go to: boston.gov/disability/wav

Getting a WAV Taxi in Boston

- This guide contains the current list of “**A**” Rated ADA Compliant WAV taxis in Boston, along with the phone number and Cab Company that each WAV belongs to.
- Just call one of the Cab Companies listed and request a WAV taxi – you can ask for an “**A**” Rated WAV taxi, or you can ask for a specific taxi medallion number as listed in this guide.
